Last Meeting, January 20th

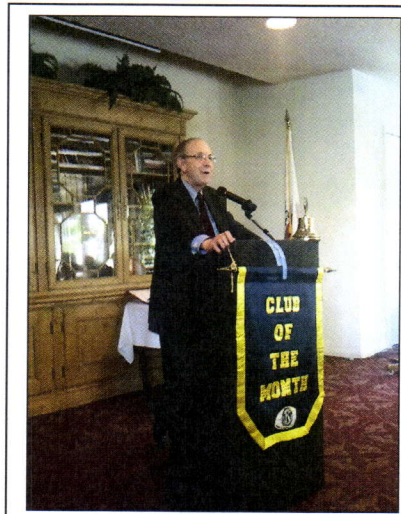
