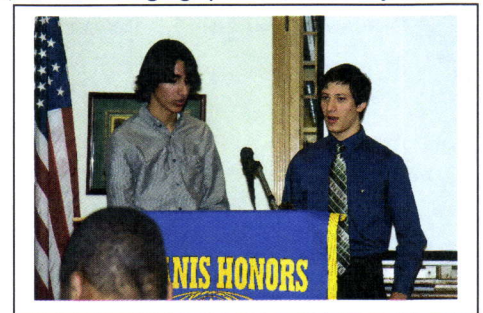
Seriously, they did a great job and we're proud of our Key Clubbers. Maybe someday they'll be members like our own Ron Moore did! But if
